**AN ACT CONCERNING POLYBROMINATED DIPHENYL ETHERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the manufacture,
- 2 sale, distribution or use of certain polybrominated diphenyl ethers on
- 3 or after January 1, 2008, and to create a civil penalty for any violation
- 4 of this prohibition.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To phase out the sale of products containing certain polybrominated diphenyl ethers to protect public health and the environment.
