**AN ACT CONCERNING THE RESTORATION OF FUNDS TO THE  
CLEAN WATER FUND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sufficient funds be appropriated to the Clean Water Fund,
- 2 from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, and
- 3 annually thereafter, to assist in implementing backlogged sewer and
- 4 denitrification construction and facility planning projects.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To restore funds that were diverted from the Clean Water Fund, and to reestablish a sufficient annual commitment for funding to assist in implementing backlogged sewer and denitrification construction and facility planning projects.
