AN ACT REQUIRING HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTORS TO BE TESTED AND LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 400 of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 licensing process for individuals registered as home improvement
- 3 contractors beginning January 1, 2009, that such contractors be
- 4 required to pass a test administered by the Department of Consumer
- 5 Protection every two years and that contractors already holding
- 6 current registrations be exempt from such testing requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To require home improvement contractors to be tested and licensed by the Department of Consumer Protection.
