**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF PARTIALLY CONSUMED
BOTTLES OF WINE FROM LICENSED PREMISES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that a partially
- 2 consumed bottle of wine that has been purchased at a licensed
- 3 restaurant or hotel dining room and has been removed from the
- 4 premises be placed in a one-time use, sealed, tamper-proof,
- 5 transparent bag with the meal receipt attached to the bag.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that wine purchased at a restaurant or hotel dining room that has been partially consumed be placed in a one-time use, sealed, tamper-proof, transparent bag if the patron wants to remove the bottle from the premises.
