**AN ACT CONCERNING DISCRIMINATION COMPLAINTS RECEIVED
BY THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46a-70a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Judicial Department to (1) maintain a record of the number of
- 3 discrimination complaints it receives and the resolution of such
- 4 complaints, and (2) report, on a regular basis, such numbers to the
- 5 Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities.

Statement of Purpose:

To document and monitor complaints of discriminatory employment practices and retaliation related to such complaints in the Judicial Department.
