**AN ACT CONCERNING REMOVAL AND STORAGE OF
POSSESSIONS OF AN EVICTED TENANT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 47a-42 of the general statutes be amended to (1) exempt
2 registered and unregistered motor vehicles, including, but not limited
3 to, trailers, boats, all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles, from the
4 possessions of an evicted tenant that a municipality must remove and
5 store once the possessions have been set out on the sidewalk, street or
6 highway by a state marshal after an eviction, and (2) permit
7 municipalities to place a lien on real property from which other
8 possessions of an evicted tenant have been removed in order to
9 reimburse the municipality for the cost of removing and storing such
10 possessions.

Statement of Purpose:

To relieve municipalities from the requirement to remove and store certain possessions of an evicted tenant and to permit municipalities to place a lien on real property from which other possession of an evicted tenant have been removed.
