**AN ACT REQUIRING THE TRAINING OF MEDICAL PERSONNEL  
CONCERNING THE PROCUREMENT OF MEDICAL RECORDS UNDER  
THE FEDERAL HIPAA LEGISLATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require medical personnel
- 2 to receive training once every two years concerning civil and criminal
- 3 procedures in relation to the federal Health Insurance Portability and
- 4 Accountability Act.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To assist police, prosecutors, public defenders and civil attorneys in procuring medical records.
