**AN ACT PROHIBITING PERSONS CONVICTED OF A FELONY BEING
EMPLOYED AS A POLICE OFFICER OR FIREFIGHTER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that,
- 2 notwithstanding the provisions of section 46a-80 of the general
- 3 statutes, no state agency or political subdivision of the state shall
- 4 employ a person who has been convicted of a felony as a police officer
- 5 or firefighter.

Statement of Purpose:

To make convicted felons ineligible for the position of municipal or
state police officer or firefighter.
