AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (10) of subsection (c) of section 7-148 of the
2 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

4 (10) (A) Make all lawful regulations and ordinances in furtherance
5 of any general powers as enumerated in this section, and prescribe
6 penalties for the violation of [the same not to exceed] such regulations
7 and ordinances in an amount not exceeding two hundred fifty dollars,
8 unless otherwise specifically provided by the general statutes. Such
9 regulations and ordinances may be enforced by citations issued by
10 designated municipal officers or employees, provided the regulations
11 and ordinances have been designated specifically by the municipality
12 for enforcement by citation in the same manner in which they were
13 adopted and the designated municipal officers or employees issue a
14 written warning providing notice of the specific violation before
15 issuing the citation;

16 (B) Adopt a code of ethical conduct;

17 (C) Establish and maintain free legal aid bureaus;

18 (D) Perform data processing and related administrative computer
19 services for a fee for another municipality;

20 (E) Adopt the model ordinance concerning a municipal freedom of
21 information advisory board created under subsection (f) of section 1-
22 205 and establish a municipal freedom of information advisory board
23 as provided by said ordinance and said section.

24 Sec. 2. Section 7-339m of the general statutes is repealed and the
25 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

26 Any municipality may establish, by ordinance [of] adopted by its
27 legislative body as provided in this chapter, [within its confines,] a
28 special services district or special services districts within the
29 boundaries of such municipality to promote the economic and general
30 welfare of its citizens and property owners through the preservation,
31 enhancement, protection and development of the economic health of
32 such municipality.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
