AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO RESTORE THE JOSEPH BLAKESLEE HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
4 nine hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
5 the Department of Economic and Community Development for the
6 purpose of a grant to the town of Wallingford to restore the Joseph
7 Blakeslee House.

To provide funding for the restoration of the Joseph Blakeslee House in Wallingford.
