AN ACT CONCERNING NOT-FOR-PROFIT ENTITIES AND CHARITABLE FUNDRAISING EVENTS AT WHICH WINE IS SOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 30-37b of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

3 A charitable organization permit shall allow the retail sale of
4 alcoholic liquor by the drink to be consumed on the premises owned
5 or leased by the organization. Such permit shall be issued on a daily
6 basis subject to the hours of sale in section 30-91 and only [four] eight
7 such permits shall be issued to the same charitable organization in any
8 calendar year. The fee for a charitable organization permit shall be
9 twenty-five dollars.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To increase from four to eight the number of charitable fundraising events allowed under a charitable organization permit.
