AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF DOGS IN CELL EXTRACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No correction officer may
- 2 use a dog to assist in the removal of an inmate from a cell in a
- 3 correctional facility.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the use of dogs to facilitate the removal of uncooperative inmates from their prison cells.
