AN ACT CONCERNING OFF-PEAK ENERGY STORAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) On and after the effective
2 date of this section, the State Building Inspector and the codes and
3 standards committee shall amend the State Building Code to require
4 all newly constructed residential structures to include an energy
5 storage system capable of recycling off-peak power to peak periods.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To conserve energy use and expense by using energy from off-peak periods during peak periods, to reduce use of high polluting peak generators and to provide whole-house backup power during electrical system outages.
