AN ACT CONCERNING LEAD LEVELS AND RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To amend the general statutes to require lead soil levels for
- 2 residential real property not be greater than 1200 mg/kg, consistent
- 3 with standards set by the United States Environmental Protection
- 4 Agency.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the health of homeowners by reducing the permissible lead level in residential soil.
