AN ACT LIMITING THE LENGTH OF TIME TO FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION AGAINST A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 150 of the general statutes be amended to limit the
- 2 length of time a person has to file a complaint against a candidate
- 3 committee to not more than ninety days after the submission of such
- 4 candidate committee's final report to the State Elections Enforcement
- 5 Commission.

Statement of Purpose:

To impose a time limit for complaints to the State Elections Enforcement Commission by individuals against candidate committees.
