AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-227a of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that, in addition to any fine or sentence of imprisonment imposed, a
- 3 court shall require that a person convicted for a first violation of
- 4 drunken driving shall not operate a motor vehicle unless such motor
- 5 vehicle is equipped with an ignition interlock device that prevents the
- 6 operation of such motor vehicle if the blood alcohol content of the
- 7 operator exceeds a predetermined limit.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent drunk driving accidents.
