**AN ACT CONCERNING FISHERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of  
2 Environmental Protection to submit a report regarding fishers not later  
3 than January 1, 2008, and annually thereafter, to the joint standing  
4 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
5 relating to the environment and planning and development, and that  
6 such report include all available and relevant data involving fishers  
7 within the state of Connecticut including, but not limited to, any  
8 reports of fisher sightings, the number of any attacks of domestic  
9 animals by fishers and the details regarding any such attack, data  
10 regarding the fisher population increase or decrease, as the case may  
11 be, and the location of fishers within the state of Connecticut.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Department of Environmental Protection to submit an annual report regarding fishers.
