AN ACT REQUIRING AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE DISCOUNTS FOR DRIVERS FIFTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND OVER WHO COMPLETE AN ACCIDENT PREVENTION COURSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (a) of section 38a-683 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to lower the eligibility age for automobile insurance
- 3 premium discounts from sixty-two years of age to fifty-five years of
- 4 age for those individuals who have submitted proof of successful
- 5 completion of an accident prevention course approved by the
- 6 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance driver safety by encouraging individuals fifty-five years of age and older to take and pass an accident prevention course approved by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.
