**AN ACT CONCERNING AUDITS OF MUNICIPALITIES BY THE  
AUDITORS OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended (1) to authorize the Auditors  
2 of Public Accounts, upon request of the Governor, to review the  
3 budget and financial condition of any municipality in which the total  
4 state grants in a fiscal year exceeds thirty-five per cent of the operating  
5 budget of the municipality for the preceding fiscal year, and (2) to  
6 require said auditors prepare a report of their review along with  
7 recommendations on programmatic savings, efficiencies, financial  
8 improvements and reforms in the municipality and submit such report  
9 to the Governor and joint standing committees of the General  
10 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to planning and  
11 development, appropriations and the budgets of state agencies, and  
12 finance.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow the Auditors of Public Accounts to audit municipalities that receive a significant amount to state funding.
