AN ACT RESTORING CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY IN THE HUSKY PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 17b-292 of the general statutes be amended to provide
2 that a child who has been determined to be eligible for benefits under
3 either the HUSKY Plan Part A or Part B shall remain eligible for such
4 plan for a period of twelve months from such child's determination of
5 eligibility unless the child attains the age of nineteen or is no longer a
6 resident of the state, regardless of any changes in family composition
7 or family income. During the twelve-month period following the date
8 that a child is determined eligible for the HUSKY Plan, Part A or Part
9 B, the department shall not require the family of such child to report
10 changes in family income or family composition.

Statement of Purpose:

To restore continuous eligibility in the HUSKY Plan, Part A and Part B.
