AN ACT CONCERNING THE GASOLINE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a nonlapsing
- 2 account within the General Fund for the receipts that were derived
- 3 from the Attorney General's investigation of gasoline price gouging.
- 4 The account shall include revenues received from the gross receipts tax
- 5 on gasoline which were in excess of estimated revenues at the time of
- 6 enactment. Funds in the account shall be used to reduce the overall tax
- 7 per gallon that motorists pay at the pump.

Statement of Purpose:

To use unanticipated revenues from the gross receipts tax on gasoline to offset the effect of a reduction in gasoline taxes paid at the pump.
