AN ACT CONCERNING CAFE PERMITS, JUICE BARS AND PAYMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 30-22c of the general statutes be amended to impose a
- 2 civil penalty of five hundred dollars per day upon the holder of a cafe
- 3 permit who fails to pay the cost of providing police presence at a juice
- 4 bar event. Such penalty shall begin thirty days after the invoice is due
- 5 and payable. Failure to pay the invoice and accrued penalty within one
- 6 hundred twenty days shall constitute grounds for revocation of the
- 7 cafe permit.

Statement of Purpose:

To impose a penalty on the holder of a cafe permit who fails to pay the cost of providing police presence at an event where the premises is used as a "juice bar".
