**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REDUCTION OR REVOCATION OF
RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS CONVICTED OF A
CRIME RELATED TO OFFICIAL DUTIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that if any person
- 2 is convicted or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to any crime related to
- 3 state, municipal or quasi-public agency office, the court may, as part of
- 4 the sentence imposed, reduce or revoke any retirement or other benefit
- 5 or payment of any kind to which the person is otherwise entitled
- 6 under the general statutes for service as a public official, municipal
- 7 employee or state employee.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce or revoke retirement benefits when a public official commits a crime related to his or her official duties.
