**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FALL
PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF
AGE OR OLDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health to establish a state-wide public
- 3 information program for the distribution of materials, including, but
- 4 not limited to, pamphlets, films and public service announcements on
- 5 fall prevention for persons sixty-five years of age or older.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the number of falls experienced by persons sixty-five years of age or older.
