AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF PETS IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that when a court
- 2 issues a restraining or protective order in a domestic violence case it
- 3 may include a provision that prohibits the respondent from harming
- 4 or threatening to harm a domestic pet.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect pets in domestic violence cases by authorizing a court to include a prohibition on harming a pet when it issues a restraining or protective order.
