AN ACT REQUIRING THE VIDEOTAPING OF CUSTODIAL INTERROGATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 54 of the general statutes be amended to require all
- 2 custodial interrogations of persons suspected of or charged with a
- 3 capital felony or a class A or B felony to be videotaped.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the videotaping of custodial interrogations of suspects in serious felony cases.
