AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF CHILD ACTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 557 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 anyone employing children in the entertainment industry to comply
- 3 with child labor laws, including those concerning number of work
- 4 hours and times during which a minor may work, require the
- 5 provision of tutors as appropriate and require compliance with state
- 6 truancy laws.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children in the entertainment industry from child labor abuses.
