AN ACT CONCERNING SUMMER SCHOOL FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-265g of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 for summer reading programs in New Haven for children enrolled in
- 3 kindergarten who are determined by their teachers to need additional
- 4 reading and instruction, and to require students in grades one to three
- 5 who are determined to be substantially deficient in reading based on
- 6 the May administration of the Developmental Reading Assessment to
- 7 attend summer school.
