AN ACT CONCERNING REGIONAL BOARDS OF FINANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to allow any town
- 2 that is a member of a regional school district to, pursuant to a vote of
- 3 its legislative body, petition the regional board of education to hold a
- 4 public district meeting concerning the establishment of a regional
- 5 board of finance. Such meeting shall be held no later than thirty days
- 6 following receipt of the petition, and no later than seventy-five days
- 7 after the receipt of the petition, referenda shall be held in each member
- 8 town. If a majority of the votes in each of the member towns is
- 9 affirmative, a regional board of finance shall be established.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for the establishment of regional boards of finance for regional school districts.
