**AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS OF THE STATE FOR THE  
PURCHASE OF OPEN SPACE AND FARM LAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of one hundred million dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Environmental Protection, from the General Fund
- 3 surplus, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, for the purchase of
- 4 open space and farm land.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To dedicate one hundred million dollars of the state budget surplus to the preservation of Connecticut's open space and farm lands.
