**AN ACT CONCERNING A LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TERMINAL  
HAZARD ZONE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that (1) the
- 2 Attorney General and the Department of Emergency Management and
- 3 Homeland Security make recommendations to the United States Coast
- 4 Guard regarding the designation of a hazard zone in relation to a
- 5 liquefied natural gas terminal located or proposed to be located on
- 6 Long Island Sound that will impact Connecticut waters or land, and (2)
- 7 the Governor, the General Assembly and the joint standing committees
- 8 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the
- 9 environment and public safety approve such hazard zone.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security and the Attorney General to make recommendations regarding any hazard zone designated in relation to a proposed liquefied natural gas terminal and to give the Governor and General

Assembly the authority to approve such designation by the United States Coast Guard.
