**AN ACT CONCERNING CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEMS IN
EMERGENCY VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-100a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that emergency vehicles transporting a child six years of age and under
- 3 and weighing less than sixty pounds shall provide and require the use
- 4 of a child restraint system.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that emergency vehicles transporting a child six years of age and under and weighing less than sixty pounds shall provide and require the use of a child restraint system.
