**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR RESTORATION
OF THE PINNEY HOUSE IN ELLINGTON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
- 5 the Department of Economic and Community Development for the
- 6 purpose of a grant to the town of Ellington for renovation of Pinney
- 7 House in Ellington.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funds for restoration of Pinney House in Ellington, once owned by Eleazer Pinney, a hero of the Battle of Saratoga.
