**AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED FUNDING FOR INTERDISTRICT
MAGNET SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-264~~l~~ of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 for increased funding with built-in annual increases for interdistrict
- 3 magnet schools.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for increased funding for interdistrict magnet schools to help the schools face rising costs.
