AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY EFFICIENT VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize municipalities to
- 2 abate property taxes on hybrid and alternative passenger vehicles with
- 3 a corporate average fuel economy of more than forty miles per gallon.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage use of energy efficient and environmentally-friendly vehicles by authorizing towns to abate property taxes on passenger vehicles utilizing low emission alternative fuel or hybrid technology.
