**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONCOMITANT SUBMISSION OF A PREQUALIFICATION CERTIFICATION WITH CERTAIN STATE CONTRACT BID SUBMISSIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 4b-91 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2007*):

4 (d) [On and after October 1, 2004, each] Each bid submitted for a  
5 contract described in subsection (c) of this section shall include a copy  
6 of a prequalification certificate issued by the Commissioner of  
7 Administrative Services. In the event a bid is submitted without a copy  
8 of such prequalification certificate, the commissioner may provide for  
9 the submission of such prequalification certificate within a reasonable  
10 period of time, as determined by the commissioner. The bid shall also  
11 be accompanied by an update statement in such form as the  
12 Commissioner of Administrative Services prescribes. The form for  
13 such update statement shall provide space for information regarding  
14 all projects completed by the bidder since the date the bidder's

15 prequalification certificate was issued or renewed, all projects the  
 16 bidder currently has under contract, including the percentage of work  
 17 on such projects not completed, the names and qualifications of the  
 18 personnel who will have supervisory responsibility for the  
 19 performance of the contract, any significant changes in the bidder's  
 20 financial position or corporate structure since the date the certificate  
 21 was issued or renewed, any change in the contractor's qualification  
 22 status as determined by the provisions of subdivision (6) of subsection  
 23 (c) of section 4a-100 and such other relevant information as the  
 24 Commissioner of Administrative Services prescribes. [Any bid  
 25 submitted without a copy of the prequalification certificate and an  
 26 update statement shall be invalid.] In the event a bid is submitted  
 27 without such update statement, the commissioner may provide for the  
 28 submission of such update statement within a reasonable period of  
 29 time, as determined by the commissioner.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2007	4b-91(d)

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow for the submission of a prequalification certification within a reasonable time of the submission of a contract bid.
