**AN ACT CONCERNING PENALTIES FOR PERSONS WORKING AS
UNLICENSED ELECTRICIANS, PLUMBERS AND HEATING, PIPING
AND COOLING CONTRACTORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-341 of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 civil penalties for persons who work as plumbers, electricians or
- 3 heating, piping and cooling contractors without a license and impose
- 4 criminal penalties on such persons which are similar to those
- 5 established under the Home Improvement Act for persons who work
- 6 as home improvement contractors without registering with the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase civil penalties and establish criminal penalties for those persons who work as electricians, plumbers and heating, piping and cooling contractors without licenses.
