AN ACT ELIMINATING REPORTING AND RECORD RETENTION REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED ON MUNICIPALITIES IN CONNECTION WITH THE GENERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 319t of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 municipalities shall no longer be required to report quarterly data to
- 3 the Commissioner of Social Services on the administration of the
- 4 former general assistance program and to eliminate any requirement
- 5 that municipalities retain general assistance program records.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate obsolete reporting and record retention requirements imposed on municipalities with respect to the administration of the former general assistance program.
