AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYER-SPONSORED MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit healthcare entities,
- 2 excluding certain religious organizations or institutions of higher
- 3 education, that receive over one hundred million dollars in state funds,
- 4 including state Medicaid funds, from using such funds to require
- 5 employees to attend employer-sponsored meetings that have as their
- 6 primary purpose communications about religious or political matters.

Statement of Purpose:

To preserve the fundamental dignity of workers.
