AN ACT CONCERNING PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-129n of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any municipality which elects to provide property tax relief to
- 3 persons sixty-five years of age or older must also provide such relief to
- 4 persons under the age of sixty-five and disabled.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that towns providing optional property tax relief to persons sixty-five years of age or older shall also allow such relief to persons under the age of sixty-five if disabled.
