AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE MUNICIPAL RELIEF TASK FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That there be established a municipal relief task force to review (1)
- 2 existing unfunded state mandates on municipalities and school
- 3 districts to determine the necessity of such mandates and whether or
- 4 not the burden placed on municipalities and school districts by such
- 5 mandates can be reduced or eliminated, and (2) state mandates on
- 6 municipalities and school districts that are partially funded and that
- 7 such task force report its findings and recommendation to the General
- 8 Assembly on or before January 1, 2008.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the study of state mandates on municipalities and school districts.
