AN ACT CONCERNING THE AMOUNT OF A MINIMUM BID FOR MUNICIPAL PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-148v of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the minimum bid threshold for municipal projects from seven
- 3 thousand five hundred dollars to twenty-five thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the financial burden of the sealed bid process for municipalities by increasing the bid threshold to a level that warrants the administrative cost of the sealed bid process that averages two thousand five hundred dollars per bid, totaling one hundred twenty thousand dollars per year for large municipalities.
