AN ACT CONCERNING URBAN COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) remove the per project
- 2 cap on the historic preservation tax credit program, (2) promote
- 3 redevelopment of downtown urban structures into mixed-use
- 4 communities, (3) establish urban community development programs
- 5 for artists, and (4) provide incentives for supermarkets to open in
- 6 underserved urban areas.
