AN ACT CONCERNING COMMUNITY-BASED MEDICAL RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) On or before July 1, 2008,
2 The University of Connecticut School of Medicine, in consultation with
3 the Department of Public Health, shall establish one or more medical
4 residency rotations in community-based primary care practices located
5 in areas designated by the federal Health Resources and Services
6 Administration as health professional shortage areas, medically
7 underserved areas or areas with medically underserved populations.
8 For purposes of this section, "community-based primary care
9 practices" include, but are not limited to, school-based health clinics
10 and federally qualified health centers.

11 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2008*) The sum of one hundred thousand
12 dollars is appropriated to The University of Connecticut, from the
13 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, for the School of
14 Medicine, for the community-based medical residency training
15 program authorized by section 1 of this act.
