**AN ACT CONCERNING COMPASSIONATE CARE FOR VICTIMS OF
SEXUAL ASSAULT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to require each
- 2 licensed health care facility in this state that provides emergency
- 3 medical services to follow the medical standard of care for treating
- 4 victims of sexual assault, which shall include offering and dispensing
- 5 emergency contraception on the premises of the licensed health care
- 6 facility, with the acquiescence of the victim.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that victims of sexual assault receive compassionate care at licensed health care facilities in this state.
