## AN ACT CONCERNING REPAIRS TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 38a-354 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):
- 3 (a) No automobile physical damage appraiser shall require <u>or</u>
  4 <u>request</u> that appraisals or repairs should or should not be made in a
  5 specified facility or repair shop or shops.
- 6 (b) No insurance company doing business in this state, or agent or 7 adjuster for such company shall require <u>or request</u> any insured to use a 8 specific person for the provision of automobile physical damage 9 repairs, automobile glass replacement, glass repair service or glass 10 products unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the insured.
- (c) For the purposes of this section, the term "require or request" includes any act to influence a consumer's decision including, but not limited to, (1) reducing the amount of deductible or premium or offering additional warranties if the consumer chooses a preferred repair facility, or (2) suggesting that choosing a facility other than a

- 17 vehicle, a lack of guaranty for repair work or additional costs to the
- 18 insured.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit automobile physical damage appraisers from recommending to insureds that appraisals or repairs be performed by specified facilities or repair shops.
