AN ACT REQUIRING PAID LEAVE FOR VETERANS ON VETERAN'S DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each employer in
- 2 this state to provide paid leave on November eleventh of each year, in
- 3 recognition of Veterans' Day, to any veteran honorably discharged
- 4 from, or released under honorable conditions from active service in,
- 5 the armed forces if November eleventh falls on the veteran's regularly
- 6 scheduled work day.

Statement of Purpose:

To require each employer in this state to provide paid leave on November eleventh of each year, in recognition of Veterans' Day, to any veteran honorably discharged from, or released under honorable conditions from active service in, the armed forces if November eleventh falls on the veteran's regularly scheduled work day.
