AN ACT CONCERNING UNPAID LEAVE FOR VETERANS ON VETERANS' DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) Any employee who is a
2 veteran, as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103 of the general
3 statutes, or a reservist or current or past member of the Connecticut
4 National Guard, may take an unpaid holiday from such employee's
5 place of employment on the eleventh day of November. Such
6 employee may take the unpaid holiday without (1) loss of seniority,
7 benefits, longevity, retirement credit, sick leave, vacation or earned
8 overtime accumulation, or (2) being subject to any other penalty.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
