AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF PRIVATE ON-SITE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 7-247 of the general statutes, concerning municipal
2 sewerage systems, be amended to authorize municipalities to adopt an
3 ordinance regulating on-site wastewater disposal systems serving one
4 or more structures with a design flow capacity in excess of five
5 thousand gallons of effluent per day and that is owned, operated or
6 maintained by a nongovernmental entity, and that such ordinance
7 have provisions regulating septic tanks, pumps, lines treatment
8 facilities, drain fields, reserve fields, lift stations and appurtenances
9 thereto that are part of any such system.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the public health by authorizing municipalities to regulate certain private on-site wastewater systems.
