AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CONVICTED OF FRAUD OR CORRUPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to stop pension accrual for a
- 2 state employee convicted of fraud or corruption as of the date of the
- 3 act for which such employee was convicted.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase honesty in government and prevent taxpayers from having to pay the pension of state employees convicted of crimes.
